Recipe of the Month

Macaroni Salad

(To be served July 4th)

Ingredients:

- 4 cups elbow macaroni
- 1/2 cup black olives, chopped fine
- 6 whole sweet pickle slices, diced
- 3 whole green onions, sliced
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1 Tablespoon distilled vinegar
- 3 teaspoons sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- Black pepper
- 1/4 cup milk (more if needed)
- Splash of pickle juice for taste.

Directions:

Cook the macaroni according to package directions. Drain and rinse. Set aside.
 Mix together mayo, vinegar, sugar, salt, pepper. Splash in enough milk to make it pourable. Splash in pickle juice for extra flavor.
 Place cooled macaroni in a large bowl and pour 3/4 of the dressing. Toss and add more dressing as needed.
 Stir in olives and green onions. Add more of any ingredient as needed for taste. Splash in a little more pickle juice and stir.
 Chill for 2 hours!

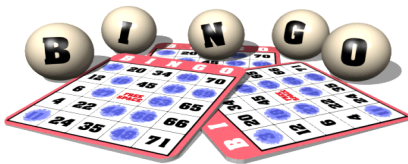

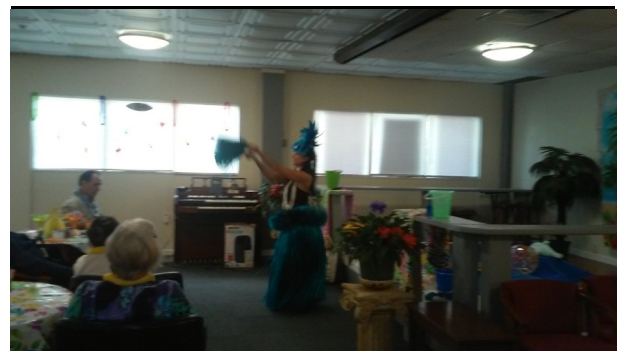
